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Louie's Loops

Materials

- Worsted Weight Yarn (Grey and Black)
- Size US-G / 4.00 mm Crochet Hook
- Needle to sew in ends
- Small amount of stuffing

Abbreviations

- Sc : Single Crochet
- Dec/Inc : Decrease/Increase
- FLO/BLO : Front/Back loops only
- Bo : Bobble stitch
- St : Stitch or stitches

Gauge : 5 Rnds and 4 stitches per 1"

Finished piece is about 2"

Worked in the round

Choosing a yarn

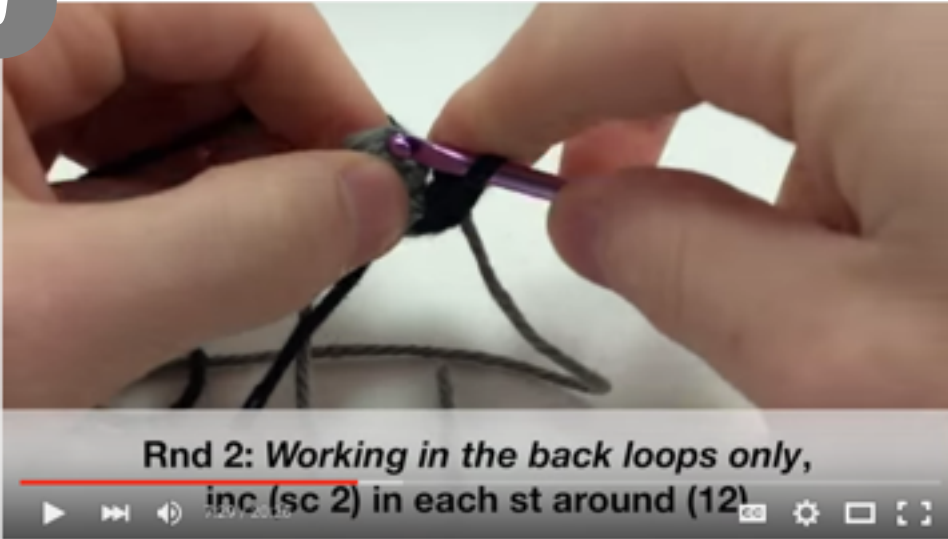
Before making our ship we have to think about what kind of yarn we want to use! Check out these two triceratops made with two different kinds of yarn:



The one on the left is made with **Lion Brand Vanna's Choice**, a weight category of 4 and a size I9/5.50mm crochet hook, and the one on the right is made with **Lily Sugar n' Creme**, with a weight category of 3 and a size G6/4.00mm crochet hook.

Keep in mind the size of your yarn and crochet hook when making amigurumi. Too big of a yarn / hook and you could be left with holes making it tough to stuff, too small of a yarn / hook and the pattern might be too difficult to complete!

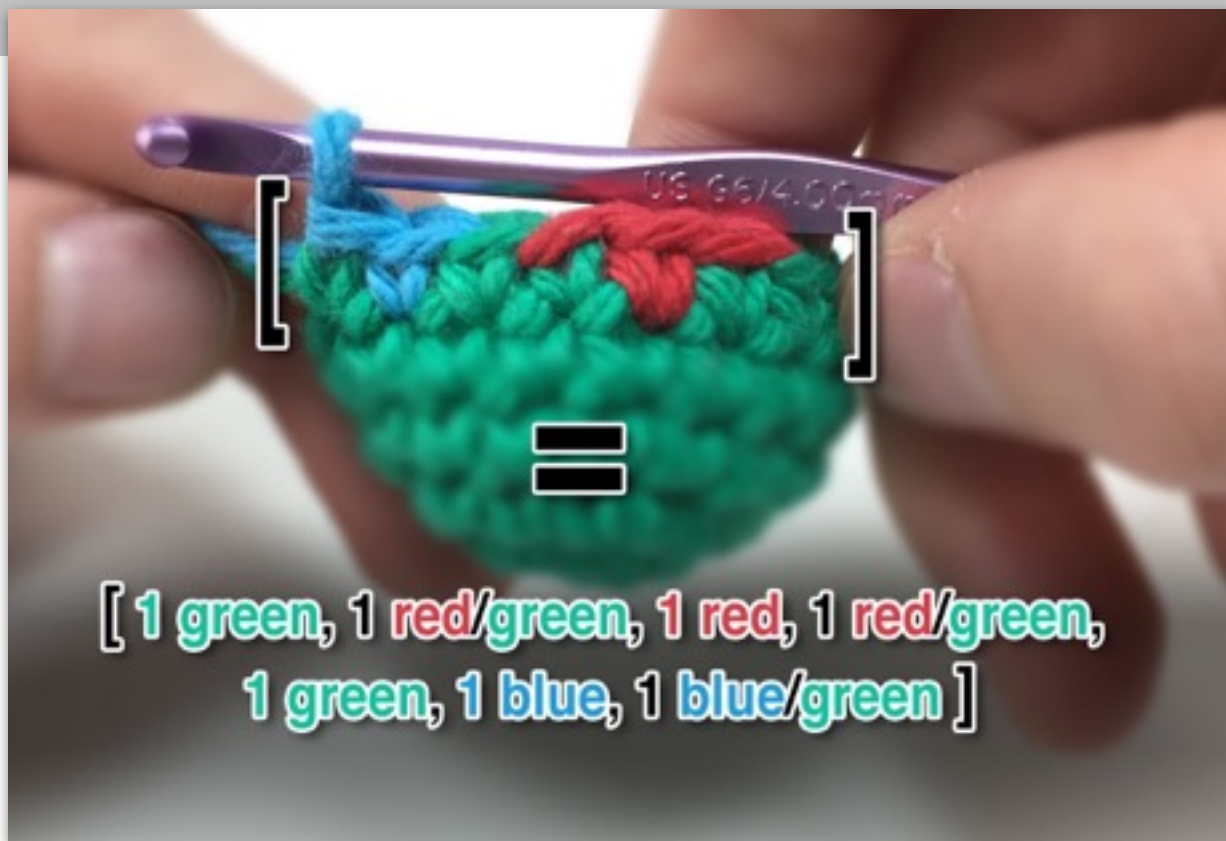

Color Changes

[See video 2]

Note: This pattern requires a lot of color changes. Be sure to check the end of each Rnd before continuing through the round to know when to change colors. Be sure to carry colors required for each round along with you before you need to do a color change.

For color changes with color/color (ex: 1 red/green), pull through the first with the first color (red), and next with the second color (green). [See diagram below]



Wing connectors

make 2

[all in grey] [See video 1]
Ch 2

(1:35) Rnd 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook or into magic hoop (4)

(2:10) Rnd 2: *Working in back loops only*, sc in each st (4)

(3:40) Rnd 3: [sc, inc] repeat twice (6)

Sew the wings onto the wing connectors. These will be sewn onto our main center piece.





Wings

make 2

[Starting in black] [See video 1]
Ch 2 (or use magic hoop method)

(5:55) Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook or into magic hoop (6) [all grey]

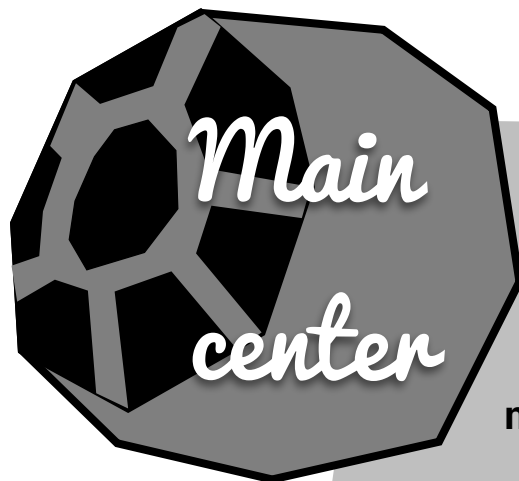
(6:55) Rnd 2: *Working in the back loops only*,
inc (sc 2) in each st around (12) [all black]

(8:20) Rnd 3: [sc, inc] repeat 6 times (18) [all black]

(10:30) Rnd 4: [sc 2, inc (ch 1 between increase sts)] repeat 6 times (24)
[all black/grey]

Ss in next, cut and pull through, sew end around to make lines for the wings





[Starting in black] [See video 2]
Ch 2 (or use magic hoop method)

(0:40) Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook or into magic hoop (6) [all black]

(1:40) Rnd 2: inc (sc 2) in each st around (12) [all black/grey]

(3:50) Rnd 3: [sc 3, inc] repeat 3 times (15) [all grey]

Embroider on the center texture

(9:00) Rnd 4-6: sc in each st (15) [all grey]

(9:45) Rnd 7: [sc 3, invdec] repeat 3 times (12) [all grey]

Sew on the wings to the side

(16:30) Rnd 8: dec in each st (6) [all grey]

Stuff, cut and sew together



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
